The No. 11/15 Marquette men's basketball team wraps up the road portion of its non-conference schedule Saturday afternoon when the squad travels to in-state rival Wisconsin. The opening tip is slated for 5 p.m. CT and will be featured on ESPN2, MU's fourth nationally televised game of the campaign. Terry Gannon (play-by-play) and Jay Bilas (analyst) will call the action from the Kohl Center.

The matchup will mark Marquette's first true road outing of the season. MU has played three neutral-site games early in 2007-08, but has yet to take the court in a true opposing environment.

Wisconsin leads the all-time series 62-51, most recently posting a 70-66 decision over the Golden Eagles in 2006-07. The Badgers currently own a 28-game homecourt winning streak, the third-longest active run in the nation. Marquette last left Madison victorious on Nov. 14, 1997, when the team earned a 65-60 decision.

Golden Eagles Reach Century Mark In Win Over UWM

Marquette renewed its series with crosstown opponent UW-Milwaukee by posting an impressive 100-65 victory over the Panthers on Nov. 30.

MU's 100-point effort marked the first time the team has reached the century mark since the 101-92 win over Missouri (3/22/03) in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

The Golden Eagles improved to 35-0 all time versus the Panthers, extending the NCAA's second-longest current winning streak over a single opponent.

Sophomore guard Maurice Acker's jumper with 1:32 remaining in the second half resulted in the 100th point being added to the scoreboard.

MU Values The Ball; Enjoys "Giving" Season Against UWM

Marquette's impressive offensive showing in the 100-point effort against UWM was the result of a number of factors, not the least of which were valuing possessions and sharing the ball.

The Golden Eagles turned the ball over on just seven occasions, matching a single-game low for a Tom Crean coached squad at Marquette. Since Crean's arrival in 1999-2000, MU has finished the night with just seven miscues in a total of seven outings. Previous to Monday night, Marquette last accomplished the feat at East Carolina on Feb. 12, 2005.

The Golden Eagles also picked up 26 assists on 40 baskets in the win over the Panthers, collecting an assist-to-turnover ratio of nearly 4-to-1. MU last collected that many assists in an 88-40 victory over Lewis on Dec. 28, 2005.

McNeal, Matthews Continue To Crash The Boards

One of the keys to Marquette's success this season will be the consistency of the guard corps to contribute on the glass at both ends of the court.

Through games of Dec. 3, junior Jerel McNeal currently tops all league guards with a season average of 4.8 rebounds per game. Classmate Wesley Matthews is contributing 4.2 boards per outing to rank sixth among players at his position.

Marquette's guards are currently combining to chip in 16.9 rebounds per game or 48.0 percent of the team's 35.2 boards per outing.

Among all of the guards returning from 2006-07, Matthews (5.3 rpg.) and McNeal (4.8 rpg.) ranked first and second, respectively, in terms of caroms per contest.



Despite The Cold, MU's Shooting Touch Warming Up

Temperatures in Milwaukee have dropped significantly in recent weeks, but the cold weather hasn't kept the shooting touch for the team from heating up.

Following the squad's 54.1 percent-effort against UW-Milwaukee, Marquette is shooting 49.7 percent from the field as a team to rank first in the BIG EAST and 33rd in the nation through games of Dec. 2.

Five players on the roster are currently shooting 50.0 percent-or-better from the floor on the season and including those attempts inside the 3-point line only, the squad's overall effort jumps to 57.0 percent (134-of-235).

Sophomore Lazar Hayward is tops on the roster, connecting on 30-of-51 (58.8 percent) of his field goal chances to rank fifth in the BIG EAST.

No Sophomore Slump In The Works For Hayward

Forward Lazar Hayward enjoyed a successful debut campaign at the collegiate level in 2006-07, finishing with season averages of 6.6 points and 3.6 rebounds per game.

He started 16 of the squad's 34 outings and shot 42.8 percent from the field and 66.7 percent from the charity stripe.

The Buffalo, N.Y., native has improved his numbers across the board in 2007-08. He is currently contributing 12.8 points and 5.8 rebounds per game in just 25.3 minutes per night. Hayward is shooting 58.8 percent from the floor and has knocked down 14-of-18 (77.8 percent) of his free throw chances.

Hayward was tabbed to the BIG EAST Honor Roll for the week of Dec. 3 after posting his first career double-double in the win over UWM. He finished with 19 points and 11 rebounds in 29 minutes of action.

McNeal Adding To His Contributions

Junior Jerel McNeal, already established as one of the top defenders in the nation, has stepped up his production at the offensive end of the court in 2007-08.

The reigning BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year is contributing 16.0 points per game this season while shooting 52.8 percent from the field. He has reached the 20-point mark in three of the team's first six outings, a feat he had accomplished on just two occasions in his first 60 career appearances.

McNeal is also third on the team in rebounding (4.8 rpg.) and second in steals (2.0 spg.).

James Latest Member of 1,000-Point Club At MU

Junior guard Dominic James, a First Team All-BIG EAST honoree and preseason All-America selection, reached the 1,000-point plateau in the second half of the Nov. 12 win over Utah Valley.

He knocked down a free throw at the 16:13 mark and quickly recorded his 1,001st point with his second charity toss.

He is the 38th player all-time and first since Steve Novak in 2005-06 to reach the mark. James is the seventh player (Travis Diener, Cordell Henry, Scott Merritt, Novak, Dwyane Wade and Brian Wardle) to achieve the benchmark during the Tom Crean era.

James has started each of his 71 career games at Marquette and owns a career scoring average of 15.0 points per game and has reached double figures in points in 58 of those outings.

Marquette's Jerel McNeal (865) and Wesley Matthews (693) also have legitimate shots at joining the 1,000-point club in 2007-08.

MU Continues Season-Opening Success

The Nov. 10 season-opening victory at the Bradley Center continued a successful trend for Marquette.

The Golden Eagles are 76-15 all-time in campaign lidlifters, including a 76-68 victory over IUPUI to begin the 2007-08 season. MU owns a seven-game winning streak in season openers and has claimed eight of nine during head coach Tom Crean's tenure.

The Golden Eagles had an impressive streak of 29 years in which it started 1-0, dating from 1960-61 to 1988-89. The squad has claimed 16 of its last 17 season openers.

James, McNeal Highlight Talent On Roster

Junior guards Dominic James and Jerel McNeal were both named Preseason First Team All-BIG EAST at the league's media day in late October, continuing a trend of individual recognition established early in the Tom Crean era.

The talented duo has claimed preseason spots on several all-conference teams, including Rivals.com, Blue Ribbon College Basketball Yearbook, Athlon Sports and Lindy's.

James was a First Team All-BIG EAST honoree in 2006-07 and McNeal was tabbed the league's top defensive player as a sophomore.

"Mr. Basketball" Awards Piling Up At Marquette

"Mr. Basketball" is the highest state honor a prep athlete can receive and three members of the Marquette men's basketball program have claimed that honor during their respective standout careers.

Freshman Scott Christopherson is the most recent player to have earned the honor, claiming the accolade from the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association in 2007. Junior guard Wesley Matthews captured the award in 2005 and graduate assistant manager Julian Swartz (Waukesha South) was tabbed the state's best talent in 1999.

Freshman Mbakwe Lost For 2007-08 Campaign

Freshman forward Trevor Mbakwe will miss the 2007-08 season due to an isolated fibular collateral ligament sprain to his left knee.

Mbakwe will redshirt in 2007-08 and have four seasons of eligibility remaining. The St. Paul, Minn., native will have surgery in the coming weeks and immediately begin the rehabilitation process.

Mbakwe's surgery will also allow the opportunity to address a pre-existing condition in the same knee, which has served as a consistent source of pain and would have limited his productivity this season.

BIG EAST To Include All 16 Teams In League Tourney

The Presidents of the BIG EAST Conference voted to include all 16 member institutions in the men's and women's basketball championship tournaments beginning in 2009.

Currently, the top 12 teams in the final regular-season standings advance to participate in the men's and women's championships. The men's championship is held in New York City at Madison Square Garden. The women's championship is held in Hartford, Conn., at the Hartford Civic Center.

The new format will have the teams seeded 9 through 16 meet on the first day of competition. The matchups will be No. 9 vs. No. 16, No. 10 vs. No. 15, No. 11 vs. No. 14 and No. 12 vs. No. 13.

The winners of those four games will meet seeds 5 through 8 on the second day of play. The 9/16 winner will advance to play the No. 8 seed. The 10/15 winner will play the No. 7 seed. The 11/14 winner will meet the No. 6 seed. The 12/13 winner will play the No. 5 seed.

Those four winners will advance to play the top four seeds in the quarterfinal round. Thus, the top four seeded teams still will not play until the quarterfinals, which occurs in the current 12-team format.

Marquette Tabbed Third In Preseason Coaches Poll

The Marquette University men's basketball team has been picked to finish third in the league according to the 2007-08 BIG EAST Preseason Coaches' Poll. The Golden Eagles collected 191 points, just behind preseason co-favorites Georgetown and Louisville, which each earned 217 points in the balloting. Fourth-place Pittsburgh received 170 points. The league's 16 head coaches did not place their own teams on their respective ballots.

James Named To Wooden Watch List

Marquette University junior Dominic James has been named to the preseason watch lists for both the John R. Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy, which honor the nation's top collegiate talent.

The Richmond, Ind., native, who was recently named to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Team, is one of 50 players to make the cut for the Wooden Award. The listing includes eight players from the BIG EAST Conference.

The list is composed of 50 student athletes who, based on last year's individual performance and team records, are the early frontrunners for college basketball's most coveted trophy. These top 50 candidates are comprised of returning players. Transfers, freshmen, and medical redshirts are not eligible for this preseason list, but will be evaluated and considered for both the Midseason Top 30 list and the National Ballot.

In Tom Crean's eight seasons, Marquette has averaged over 20 wins a year, won a conference championship and made seven postseason appearances, highlighted by the 2003 Final Four, the program's third appearance all-time and first since 1977.

He is a two-time recipient of the Ray Meyer Conference USA, NABC District XI and USBWA District V Coach of the Year awards, and in 2003 won the Coach Clair Bee Award as well as being named a finalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year Award.

Crean's 65.7 winning percentage and 165 victories place him third in both categories all-time at Marquette.

National Recognition

Crean's revival of Marquette's storied basketball program has not gone unnoticed by the national pollsters as the Golden Eagles have spent 62 weeks in the rankings since November 2001.

Prior to first appearing during Crean's tenure in the AP Top 25 on November 27, 2001,

Marquette had been ranked for just 24 weeks the previous 15 seasons.

Marquette's consecutive year-end rankings in 2002 and 2003 were the first time for the program in a quarter century, and on March 4, 2003, the school earned its highest ranking since 1978 by reaching No. 8 in the AP poll, which the team matched in 2006-07.

Player Development

Personally driven by an intense commitment to improve, Crean has structured a program at Marquette that focuses heavily on individual instruction and has allowed his players to stay ahead of the competition.

The development of Golden Eagle players under Crean's tutelage can best be illustrated by the program's representation with international basketball this past summer. Current players Dominic James, Wesley Matthews and Jerel McNeal were all invited to tryouts for USA Basketball to represent the country at the 2007 Pan American Games. Recognized among the top young talent in collegiate basketball, Marquette's trio of selections was the most of

Through eight seasons, Golden Eagles players have earned 19 All-Conference selections and the program's first conference player of the year award, when Dwyane Wade won Conference USA's top honor in 2003. Wade also went on to become the first Marquette player since 1978 to be named an Associated Press First Team All-America and finalist for the John R. Wooden Award.

The 2007 season saw a pair of Golden Eagles rated among the league's best. Sophomore guard Dominic James was tabbed first team all-league and classmate Jerel McNeal was named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year. He also claimed a spot on the all-conference second team.

In 2006, Steve Novak was one of four unanimous selections to the All-Big East first team. Novak was selected 32nd overall by the Houston Rockets in 2006 NBA Draft.

In 2005, Travis Diener joined Wade as players under Crean's mentoring who earned All-American and All-Conference honors, as well as going on to be selected in the NBA Draft.

Marquette basketball has been represented on national player of the year balloting in each of the last six seasons.

Fan Support and Television Exposure

Crean's passion and commitment on the court has paid dividends off of it. The program has set total attendance records four times, and since 1999 has drawn nearly two million fans.

Students on the Milwaukee campus have flocked to the Bradley Center in record numbers, making it one of college basketball's best environments. Marquette has finished among the nation's top-25 in average attendance in each of the last six seasons, including a clip of 15,345 per game in 2006-07 to rank 14th overall.

Overall, attendance has increased 70-percent and the top 10 crowds of all-time have occurred during Crean's tenure (all coming since 2002). Marquette's elevated status nationally has made it a favorite of television. Crean's squad has had 87 games televised nationally on network or cable since 2001.

Career Overview

Crean was named the 15th head coach in Marquette basketball history on March 30, 1999.

Before arriving in Milwaukee, Crean served on the Michigan State basketball staff for four seasons, holding the position of associate head coach for the last two. During that time, the Spartans compiled an 88-41 record and made four consecutive postseason appearances, including a trip to the 1999 Final Four. Michigan State's recruiting coordinator; Crean was instrumental in bringing two-time Big Ten Player of the Year Mateen Cleaves and 2000 John R. Wooden Award finalist Morris Peterson to East Lansing.

Prior to his tenure at Michigan State, Crean spent the 1994-95 season as an assistant coach at Pittsburgh and served as the associate head coach at Western Kentucky from 1990 to 1994. Crean got his start in coaching on the Division I level in 1989-90, serving on Jud Heathcote's staff at Michigan State.

A native of Mount Pleasant, Mich., Crean earned his bachelor's degree in parks and recreation with a minor in psychology from Central Michigan in 1989. While pursuing his degree, Crean coached basketball at Alma College and Mount Pleasant High School.

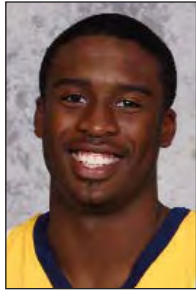

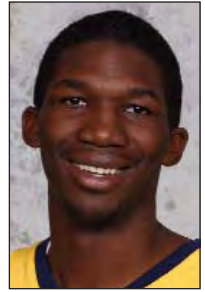

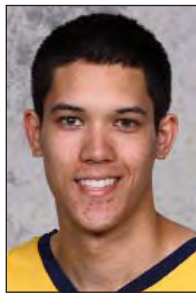

Jerel McNeal scored 20 points to lead the No. 11 Golden Eagles to a 76-68 comeback victory over IUPUI on Saturday night in the season opener for both teams.

Marquette trailed 48-43 with 13 minutes left after IUPUI used a 17-2 run to erase a 10-point lead for the Golden Eagles shortly after halftime.

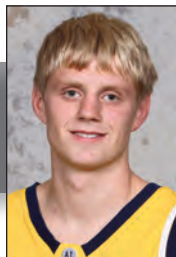

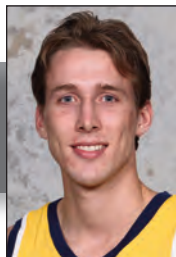

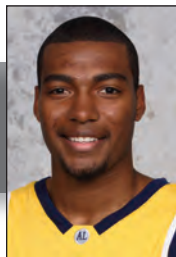
